SCRANTON RAILWAY COMPANY HAS PUT IN HEAVIER RAILS AND TIES ON WEST LAKEWANNA AVENUE—REPORTS OF HIGHWAY ROBBERIES AGAIN COME FROM THE KEYBER VALLEY SECTION.

Probably the most systematic, and in several instances the first, repairs to South Main avenue from Epton to Centre street, a distance of two blocks, is being made by the city.
