## CARBONDALE.

### FIRE ORDINANCE KILLED.

Both Branches of Council Transacted City Business Last Night.

Select and common councils held meetings last evening. Little interest was manifested in the doings of the lower house, but a number of enthusiastic firemen were present to witness the effort of members of the select body to raise the ordinance council No. 4, which provides for the maintenance of fire department. This ordinance has been tied up for about six months and those who favored it made up their minds to have it passed or killed. Messrs. Swigert and Thompson, of the fire committee, reported unfavorably and Mr. Mannion submitted a favorable minority report, which Chairman Swigert allowed to be acted on first out of courtesy. A tie vote defeated both reports, the ballot standing: Nealor, Harbo, Mannion for the ordinance and Swigert, Eaton, Thompson against it. This disposes of the measure, which provided an expenditure of \$5 a month for the Mitchell and an equal amount for Columbus, to be used for the care and maintenance of horses.

The Columbus are without a team, but proposed purchasing one as soon as this ordinance should become law. They are fully determined to not invest any money in a team until some provision for its keeping is made by the city.

Chairman Swigert called attention to the fact that common council is responsible for inaction regarding fire alarm system. The upper house will be powerless in the matter as long as the commoners neglect to pass a bond ordinance providing funds. Bond ordinances have to originate in the lower house.

Both branches adopted the following resolution: That the city clerk and light, fire and water committee be authorized to purchase the horse blankets as per requisition of Mitchell Hose company.

Chief of Police McAndrew reported shortage of electric street light of 279 hours in November and 473 hours in December.
