**O'MALLEY VERDICT IS SUSTAINED**

**PLAINTIFF WAS INJURED ON THE TROLLEY ROAD.**

On the First Trial of the Case a Non-Suit Was Granted and on Its Second Hearing a Verdict in Favor of O'Malley for \$4,675—When a New Trial Was Refused an Appeal Was Taken to the Supreme Court, Which Has Sustained the Local Court—Other Court Matters.

The Supreme court at Philadelphia yesterday handed down an opinion affirming the judgment of the court of this county in the case of Thomas O'Malley against the Scranton Railway company.

In the fall of 1894, O'Malley brought suit against the company to recover damages and in 1896 the case was heard before Judge Archbald, who granted a

non-suit on the ground that he was guilty of contributory negligence. Later, after an argument before the court en banc, the non-suit was taken off and in January, 1898, the case was tried for a second time, this time Judge Gunster presiding during the trial of the case. A verdict was returned in favor of the plaintiff for \$4,675. An application was made for a new trial, but it was refused and an appeal was taken to the Supreme court.

O'Malley is a man about 55 years of age, and lives on South Washington avenue. He was represented by O'Brien and Kelly and Hon. M. F. Sandu. When the case was first tried the company was represented by Horace E. Hand, Jessup & Jessup defended the case for the company on the second trial and Major Everett Warren argued the case before the Supreme court last February. Other cases decided of local interest were:
