SOLICITOR SAYS TOLL GATE MUST GO. OPINION READ IN COUNCIL LAST NIGHT.

States That After a Careful Examination of All the Aspects of the Case That the Nay Aug Falls and Elmhurst Boulevard Company Has No Right to Collect Toll Within the City—Resolution Directing the Removal of the Toll Gate Unanimously Adopted.

City Solicitor Vosburg sent in a lengthy and carefully prepared opinion to council last night regarding the maintenance of a toll-gate in Nay Aug park.

After the opinion had been read, Mr. Schneider, of the park committee, introduced a resolution directing the street commissioner to notify the boulevard company that the toll-gate is to be removed.

The validity of a charter granting to a turnpike road company the privilege of constructing and collecting tolls within the existing limits of a city, would be doubtful to say the least.
