Stockholders Met. The annual meeting of the stockholders of the Lackawanna Iron and Steel company was held yesterday at General Superintendent Henry Wachum's office.

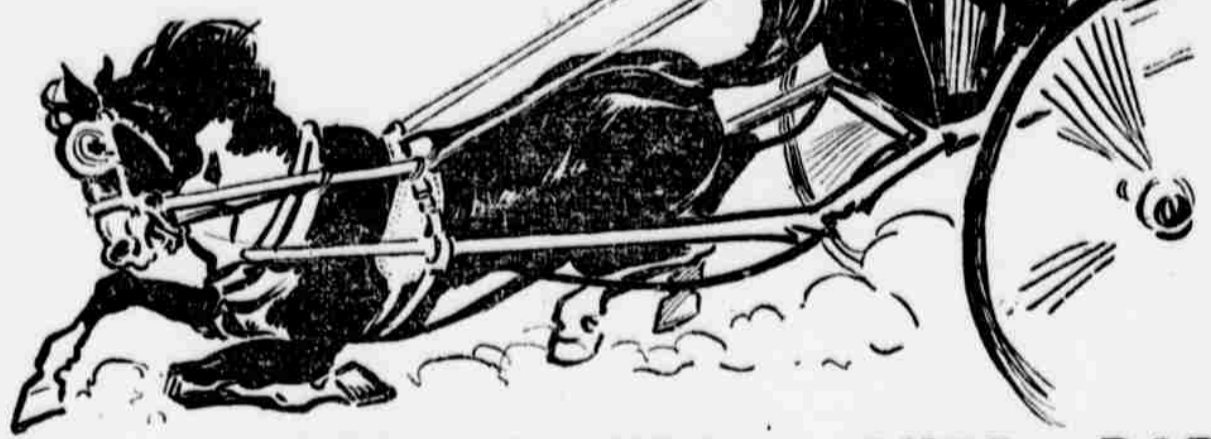
Semi-Annual Convention. The semi-annual state convention of the International Brotherhood of Stationary Firemen will be held Sunday at Plymouth.
