THE DEATH OF ex-President Harrison recalls to many people in this city memories of the wife who now mourns her great bereavement and whose early years were closely identified with this region and with many prominent residents of this city.

In those days "Minnie" Scott Lord, as she was known, was a beautiful girl who visited much in Honesdale after the removal of her family from that town to Albany. She and Walter Dimmick, a brother of Messrs. Benjamin and G. du B. Dimmick, of this city, were sweethearts from childhood. When she was twenty-one or twenty-two years old they were married at the residence of Mr. and Mrs. G. du B. Dimmick, who resided in just across the river, and who were occupying their home, which is now owned by Mr. C. D. Simpson. The ceremony was performed by Rev. Mr. Paulston, of St. Luke's church, in the east parlor, the bay window of which has remained the same, although the house itself has undergone many changes. It was in the same bay window that the only daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Simpson was married to Mr. H. Brady, Jr., rather more than a year ago.

The marriage of Mr. and Mrs. Walter Dimmick took place twenty years ago next October. The young people went west on their bridal tour and while roughing it in a far western region it is supposed that the bridegroom suffered infection from the unsanitary condition of a hotel, for on their return to New York he fell ill with typhoid fever and eleven weeks after his wedding day was carried to his grave. The stricken young wife came to Scranton, and for two years lived in the home from which she went forth as a bride. It is a peculiarly pathetic incident connected with that sojourn with her husband's relatives that at no time did she even once cross the threshold of the room where she had taken the vows of wedlock. That she mourned her young husband long and desolately is well known.
