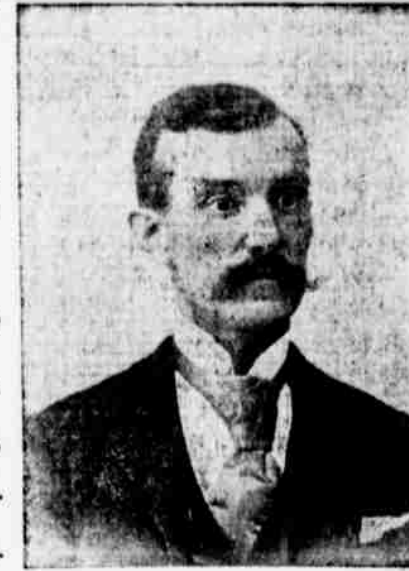
CARBONDALE'S GOLDEN JUBILEE
