SCHLEY CASE ENLIVENED

Some Important Evidence Is Followed by a Tilt Between Counsel.

WHEN THE ADMIRAL RECEIVED FIRST WORD

Schley's Counsel Contends That the Dispatch of May 27 Was the First Positive Information That Had Been Given Him Concerning the Whereabouts of Cervera's Fleet. Captain Chadwick Tells of His Protest—Lieutenant Commander Staunton Tells of the Dispatches.

Washington, Oct. 12.—Captain P. E. Chadwick, who was Admiral Sampson's chief of staff in the war with Spain, continued his testimony before the Schley court of inquiry yesterday. The admiral's witnesses were recalled for the purpose of correcting their testimony. There was only one question of the court, a division having been reached Friday to adjourn at 1 o'clock yesterday until next Monday, in order to give the members of the court and counsel an opportunity of re-examination and presentation of the case.

Captain Lemly said that he expected to conclude the presentation of the government's side of the case by the close of the session on Monday. It is understood that Mr. Rayner will be prepared to begin the presentation of Admiral Schley's witnesses immediately, and it is his intention to press the case forward as rapidly as possible.

COMMANDANT LETTER IS EXECUTED

Middleburg, Cape Colony, Oct. 12.—Commandant Lottor, the Cape rebel, whose commando, consisting almost wholly of rebels, was captured south of Petersburg in September, and who was sentenced to death, was executed yesterday morning.

Lottor had been found guilty on eight counts, including shooting the murder of unarmed colored scouts, the murder of troops in action, the blowing up of railroads and the cowardly of British subjects and Europeans. Lottor pleaded that he was a citizen of the Orange Free State, but this was disproved.
