

MURDER CASES NOT WANTING

TWO OF THEM, AS USUAL, ON THE TRIAL LIST.

Cases Set Down for the First Week of Criminal Court Includes the Murder Case Against Antoni Tomaszewski, Four Perjury and Bribery Cases Growing Out of the Big Councilmanic Scandal, and the Bribery Case Against General Manager Silliman, of the Scranton Railway Company.

Appended is the trial list for the first week of the December session of criminal court, which begins next Monday. The list is headed by the case in which Antoni Tomaszewski, of the Archbald mine, is accused of murdering a boy named Thomas by driving a pick through his head. The oft-continued cases against H. C. Hutton, Carl McKinney, E. J. Maloney and Simon Thomas are set down for the early part of the week, the Hutton case being scheduled for Monday, the Maloney and McKinney cases for Tuesday, and the Thomas case for Wednesday.

Wednesday's list also contains the case in which General Manager Frank Silliman, of the Scranton Railway Company, is charged with bribing Old Forge councilmen, and the case in which the trolley company prosecutes a former conductor, B. J. Kelly, for embezzlement. On Friday's list is the case against James Murray, of South Scranton, who is accused of assault and battery on Patrolman Tom Jones, during a street car strike riot on Stone avenue.

The case against S. E. Wayland, general manager of the Lackawanna Telephone company, in which he is charged with obstructing justice by refusing to answer questions at a hearing in the councilmanic bribery cases, is set down for Tuesday of the second week. On the list for Friday of the second week is the embezzlement case against John D. Jones, ex-tax collector of Taylor. During the first week, Judge John P. Kelly will preside in the main court room; Judge J. W. Carpenter in No. 2, and Judge George S. Ferris, of Luzerne, in No. 3. During the second week, President Judge H. M. Edwards will be in the main court room; Judge Kelly in No. 2, and Judge Frank Wheaton, of Luzerne, in No. 3.
