The unfortunate man's fall was witnessed by several other workmen who immediately ran to his assistance. They found him in an unconscious condition, unconscious with the greatest difficulty. He was removed to his home where he suffered a severe hemorrhage. Upon a thorough examination by the physician in attendance, he was found to have broken bones on the left side, in being also feared that he received internal injuries, he will probably recover.
