Sunday School Lesson for December 22. Christmas Lesson. Isa. ix: 1-7.

INTRODUCTION.—Our last lesson referred to matters connected with the exodus of Israel from Egypt. PREDICTION.—It should be borne in mind that, while our lesson records events as having already transpired, it covers the future. It is predictive and prophetic, as appears in the last clause of the last verse. It should be kept in mind that the events of the ancient time are a view of the things to come. This was clearly seen in the time of Jesus. Jesus, by his life and death, fulfilled the prediction of the Old Testament.

ANALYSIS.—The lesson falls naturally into three parts. The first part (verses 1-3) describes the present state of Israel. The second part (verses 4-6) describes the future state of Israel. The third part (verse 7) describes the future state of the world.

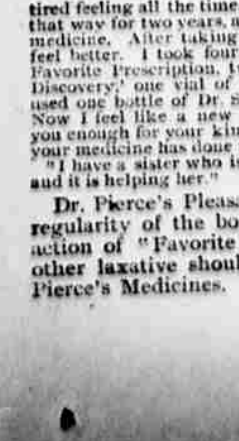
