

RELIGIOUS NEWS

THE General Assembly of the Presbyterian church now in session in New York, will on Monday and Tuesday of next week, celebrate the centennial of home missions. In all the Presbyterian churches of New York city and vicinity, and in fact throughout the country at large, discourses appropriate to the occasion of this home mission anniversary will be preached.

The march from Schenley park to Tent Endeavor under escort of the boys' brigade—five thousand children—will be an inspiring sight. The address on Junior work will be delivered by Rev. Clarence E. Eberhart, executive secretary of the Pennsylvania union, now field secretary for the united society. No better selection could be made.

Young Men's Christian Association. The annual review of the Young Men's Christian Association for its jubilee year, 1901, abounds in figures representing the advances in the multifarious departments of association work, so much so that it would not be practicable to consider them all in a single paragraph. Ten million dollars were contributed and pledged during the year to the American association in funds for buildings, endowment, and support, and for the payment of debts and extension. A building was added to its equipment every week, and seventy-seven more buildings are under construction for the future. The association numbers 1,476, while the membership is in America 288,477, and throughout the world 533,049. The Bible classes record an increase of 50 per cent.

Annual Gymnastic Meetings. The Welsh Baptist Association of Churches will hold their annual gymnastic services at Olyphant today and tomorrow, with preaching services in Welsh and English. A large number of visitors from churches throughout Northwestern Pennsylvania will be in attendance. The gymnastic of the Welsh Calvinistic Methodist churches of Pennsylvania will begin in the Bellevue Welsh C. M. church on Friday, May 23, and continue throughout Saturday and Sunday.

Rev. S. T. Jones, of the North Wales, will preach and preach at the opening service. He is regarded as one of the most eminent divines in Wales. Rev. R. T. Jones, D. D., of Philadelphia, will also be in attendance.

Ordination services will be held on Saturday afternoon, May 24, when R. O. Hughes, of Edwarsdale, will be advanced to the ministry. Preaching services will also be held Saturday evening and Sunday morning, afternoon and evening, with English services in the afternoon.

The State Association of Congregational churches will meet at Meadville, Pa., Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, May 20, 21 and 22. Rev. David Jones, pastor of the First Welsh Congregational church, is the moderator, and will preach the annual sermon Tuesday evening.

A Coronation Service. A unique service was held at the Penn avenue church a few days ago, when Miss S. C. Krigbaum received a pleasant surprise and a substantial gift from a number of the church members. Miss Krigbaum has been a faithful missionary of the church and Sunday school for the past eighteen years, and the event of her anniversary was emphasized by appropriate remarks by the pastor, Dr. Pierce, after which she presented her with a silver crown composed of silver dollars. Miss Krigbaum is one of the constituent members of the Penn avenue church, and has given her life to the religious work in this city. She is especially known throughout the city, especially in the education share (\$8 per year) and the total amount of endowment money, including that reported to the conference, promises to be much larger than in 1900, when it was about \$16,000. A considerable increase is expected in the education share (\$8 per year) of the dollar money, which was \$7,950 in 1900, the secretary having already received \$7,750, with 12 conferences to be heard from.

Bishop Derrick, of the African Methodist Episcopal church, has been invited to preach at the memorial service at the three hundred and fifty-second anniversary of the Huguenot Church of the Catacombs, in the crypt of Canterbury cathedral, England. The Colored Methodist Episcopal church has secured a tract of 100 acres in the new Negro town of Booker, near Birmingham, Ala., as a site for an institution for the highest education, the work of raising funds for which is now in progress.

Meeting of Stewards. The stewards of the Methodist Episcopal church of the Wyoming district held a meeting yesterday in the Methodist Episcopal church at West Pittston, said the Wilkes-Barre Record of Thursday. "There was a large attendance. Rev. Dr. Griffin presided. The secretary was T. W. Kite. The presiding elder's report was agreed on to remain the same as last year. "A resolution was adopted that every minister in the district should arouse his parishioners to take the greatest possible interest in the Wyoming campaign and to keep up the good work from year to year. A committee was appointed relative to the revision of the districts of the Wyoming conference from six to five districts."
