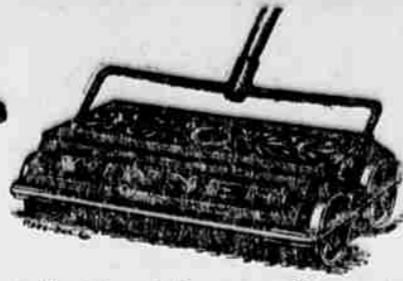

THE MARKETS.

Wall Street Review.

New York, Dec. 11.—The stock market today when an eager untending of securities was in progress without regard to prices. The volume of doing rose to over a million shares or about double those of yesterday, which were again more than double those of the day before. The throwing upon the market of this greatly augmented volume of liquidation met with very poor absorption, however, and violent declines were the result. There were points in the market, where more resistance was shown than in others, notably amongst the Pennsylvania group, heading the Antigonish Copper and Sugar. The last named stock closed today with an actual gain of 1/4 cent, of a small fraction. On the other hand, the Rock Island stocks, the United States Steel stocks and the Pacific generally proved easily vulnerable. The extreme decline in Rock Island common was 3/4 cent and in the preferred 1/2 cent. The final prices were respectively 1/2 cent higher than the lowest. United States Steel lost 3/4 cent and the preferred 1/2 cent and their final prices were only a fraction better than these low points. The unsupported condition of these stocks had a strong sentimental effect on the whole market. The Venezuelan situation exerted only a sensational influence. Total sales today, 1,100,000 shares. Bonds were weak in sympathy with stocks. Total sales, par value, \$4,200,000. United States 4s and old 4s coupon declined 1/4 per cent. on the last call.
