CONGRESSIONAL.

Washington, Jan. 23.—Senate—Mr. Smith presented petition for the repeal of the fugitive slave law, which was laid on the table. The Senate, in a grueling session, voted a resolution giving a pension to Gen. Barton's heirs. It was passed.

A resolution of inquiry relating to the cost of dry dock at San Francisco was adopted. At noon the Senate adjourned to inquire into the expediency of suspending the trial of the Boston Massacre, and the French legislation was taken up. The 11th amendment to the Constitution was voted up. The bill ordered to be engrossed. Veto 30.

The Senate, after an executive session, adjourned.

The reports of standing committees were called for and read. Among them was one reported by Mr. McLean, whose bill gave farms to the Indians, upon which he had labored. A bill, which remained upon the table, was referred to a committee of three, who recommended its adoption. The House then took up the deficiency bill, and, after some further debate, the House adjourned.

PENNSYLVANIA. Philadelphia, Jan. 23.—Rev. Walter Collyer, the Governor of California, died at his residence yesterday, also Adam Fricker, for a long time President of the City Council.

OHIO LEGISLATURE. Columbus, Jan. 23.—A resolution was passed by a vote of 63 to 13, authorizing the state to lease the Ohio and Mississippi rivers, also to improve the Western Lakes. Another was passed by a vote of 40 to 10, urging Congress to increase our marine and naval forces in the Pacific, by rail road and otherwise.

A portion of the Democratic press were opposed to the resolutions, but the last, and the votes are fair indications of the views of the legislature on this subject.

MASSACHUSETTS ELECTION. Boston, Jan. 23.—The House voted yesterday for the calling of a State convention. The whole number of members was 157; Wm. C. Storer received 157, Wm. C. Storer, 129, and John D. Durfee, 59. There were consequently no change. Storer has gained 4 upon the preceding election.
