To make the above wash a pleasing cream color, add 4 flee yellow ochre.

For fawn color, take 4 flow umber., 1 b Indian red, and 1 h lamphlack.

The color may be put on with a sommon whitewash, as the sulphate of sincests or hardens the whitewash.
