

HOME MATTERS.

Court of Queen's Sessions.—The case of Com. vs. John Galster, indictment assault and battery, was the first taken up in this Court yesterday. The assault and battery being clearly made out the jury returned a verdict of guilty. The Court sentenced the defendant to pay the sum of £10.

The Court then sentenced three men named Rosenthal, convicted of assault and battery some two or three weeks ago, to pay ten dollars and the costs of Court.

Com. vs. Wm. Davidson, indictment assault and battery, on oath of Mrs. Robbie. This was an unimportant case. The defendant was found guilty and sentenced to pay a fine of \$10.

A number of entries of the peace cases were taken up and disposed of.

Argued on the demuror to the refusal of a liquor license to Henry Rea of the Sixth Ward by the Court was made by Messrs. Bruce and Alden, who then made those gentlemen. It was agreed that the opinion of the law director, who certify that he has examined the facts of the case, will be submitted to the Government. The Senate went into Executive session, and then adjourned.

Hobes.—Mr. Houston moved that the House meet at eleven o'clock in future, and that the speaker be given power to adjourn the House after one o'clock each day until all were disposed of.

John Linton of Arkansas, moved to take up the Senate bill to confer citizenship on John W. Kinney, of Stockbridge, Ind., and other foreign citizens.

It was agreed to postpone the debate.

The case occupied the attention of Court until the hour of adjournment.
