

HOME MATTERS.

RIVER INFERNO.—The river is still receding; the depth of water at Saturday evening was 74 feet.

BALTIMORE.—The wharf on Saturday was rather than for a few days previous. The boats from Louisville, however, had a heavy load—about the largest, for an ordinary-sized boat, we have seen this season. The departure, from St. Louis, had also a full cargo, of meat, lead, &c. See our list of imports.

The *Globe* was covering the landing in her neighborhood with news—upwards of 8000 bags left her on her cargo.

The *Hudson*, Standard, with 150 passengers, and a full cargo of freight, among which we notice a drove of over 100 cattle, for the East. Notwithstanding the efforts of the Louisville and Wheeling to induce a belief to the contrary, the packets of our line are having a fair run.

We note, every day, at the upper end of the river, a large amount of produce, delivered by the Wabash and Mississippi. They bring up, every day, a vast amount of produce, and take away a large quantity of groceries and Pittsburgh manufactures. The extent of this trade is not properly appreciated.

The Wheling packet for this morning is the "Winnipeg."

IMPORTANT DECISION BY JUDGE MCCARTHY.—Some weeks ago a suit was tried before the Court of Quarter Sessions against the School Directors of Reserve township, for forcibly entering and detaining a school teacher. A year ago Woods, sentenced to pay the costs. Not being able to do so, he was thrown into prison. Alex. M. Watson, Esq., Woods' counsel, presented a petition to the Court, on Saturday, for the release of Woods, by giving an insufficient bond, according to the forty-second section of the act of 1850, to the effect that if the verdict of the jury was not a fit, and consequently the provider in that act did not reach the case in consideration: therefore the prisoner, a citizen of the Commonwealth, was entitled to a discharge on giving bond, as in civil cases.

The finding of the jury, said the Court, was the sentence of the Court. His Honor, however, in a similar case, which was tried before him, and in which Woods was sentenced to pay the costs. Not being able to do so, he was thrown into prison. Alex. M. A section of the act of 1850 was read by his Honor, in which this doctrine was supported. As Woods has been in a few weeks, his petition was dismissed at the cost of petitioner.

After an absence of nearly six days, the DeLaney jury came into Court with a verdict of guilty against the prisoner, Mary Delaney. The verdict excited great astonishment in the audience.

Mrs. Darragh, one of the counsel for defendant, after the jury was discharged, filed an exception to the verdict, viz., that the Foreman had merely written a handwritten note to the jury, in which he had told them to give the prisoner three months at least, before applying for a new trial.
