PENNSYLVANIA STATE AGRICULTURAL FAIR AT PITTSBURGH.

THE STATE FAIR GROUNDS.—The buildings on the Fair Ground have been nearly completed, according to the report of the Secretary of the State, Mr. George W. C. Watson. All the large frame buildings are finished, and several of the tents have been erected. The first day of the Fair will be Saturday, Oct. 29th, and the second Sunday, Oct. 30th.

The opening Match of the Pennsylvania State Agricultural Fair will be at 1 P.M. on Saturday, Oct. 29th, in the city, on Friday, the 28th, at 2 P.M. at the Fair Grounds.
