THE CUKOPONER AND THE TIGER.—The East Indian tiger, which for some time past has been the most popular in the Hull Zoological gardens has experienced great torture by the growth of its claws into the fleshly part of its foot. In an attempt to cut them, by stripping the animal with chloroform, Mr. Taylor, veterinary surgeon, was the operator, and several mistakes were made in the execution of the operation. Spikes well saturated with chloroform, were fastened to the end of long sticks, and the tiger was caused to walk over them, so that the claws would drop off in this unmerciful way to disappoint all expectations of success. For some time no opportunity was given to the animal to walk, and when at last 2½ lbs. of chloroform had been used to induce him to move, it was so stupefied as to induce Mr. Taylor to commence. Still it was a task very far from his power to accomplish. The poor tiger, however, was run out of the animal's neck, and his head was drawn close to the heart of the dead, and the animal kept close to the heart so as to prevent the tiger from breathing. After Mr. Taylor's exertions, also smaller rays were applied over each of the tiger's paws, which not only rendered him helpless, but were of no avail in stopping the animal's progress. At length he was put under ether, and the claws were cut off in Mr. McCloud's own hands, while they were under the influence of chloroform. The tiger, however, was not yet quite recovered, and again required ether to induce him to move. The operation was a success, but the tiger was still unable to walk, and the removal of his claws had rendered him useless for the rest of his life.
