Now, it is impossible for any steamboat law to protect any boat against snags, or storms, or fire. These each and all set law at defiance. Every boat that ventures out upon the river is subjected more or less to the danger of fire, and is protected from it only by the provident care and watchfulness of those in charge of it; while on the Mississippi, and especially on the lower part of it, there is no protection whatever against snags or storms. It will be seen, therefore, that the majority of the late accidents are not traceable to any defect in the law. In regard to the Kate Kearney, the explosion on board of her could not have happened, we think, under a faifful administration of the steamboat law. She ought nover to have been permitted to run, being old and unseaworthy; and had the law been enforced, as it should have been the round of which we have happened and driven out of use. The explo-

Such awfal casualties can be prevented, and ought to be.—Humanity and justice unite in demanding a faithful explanation and exposure of the fact, and the application of whitever remedy is needed.
