CONVENTION OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS.—At 10 o'clock yesterday, the School Directors of the County met in session, to elect the provisions of an Act passed at the last session of the Legislature.

On motion, Mr. Bigelow, of Lower St. Clair, was called to the chair.

Messrs. Samuel Chalwick, Collins Tp., J. K. Scott, McLeansport, H. McLean, Manchester, W. Morris, Shadyside, and C. G. Moore, of Penn Township, were elected Vice Presidents.

J. W. Lewis, Third Ward, city; S. P. W. Gill, Ward, Allegheny, and Mr. Morris, of Sharpsburg, were elected Vice Presidents.

On motion, the Secretaries proceeded to the enrollment of the various Districts in their order.

On adjournment, Mr. Saville moved that the election of the Superintendent take place at two o'clock.

A motion was offered, that the Convention be adjourned, meet at one o'clock.

On motion, the whole matter was laid on the table.

The Convention resolved that after the removal of delegates, the Convention remain to the 3d Ward School House.

On motion of H. D. King, the Convention proceeded to fix the amount of salary to be attached to the office of Superintendent.

The sum of \$2,500, \$1,200, \$1,500, \$1,000, \$800, \$1,000, \$1,200, \$1,000, \$500, \$800, \$500, \$1,100, \$1,200, \$1,000 were mentioned.

On motion, it was voted that the amount of five be appointed to its amount.

An amendment was offered to appoint one from each district.

The Convention was withdrawn.

A gentleman proposed that every even hundred to \$8,000, should be voted upon, which was adopted.

The Convention then named Scott, of Ross Tp., made some remarks against the bill, and urged the adoption of a small amount that no person in Allegheny County would accept of it.

A. D. Bigelow, of Lower St. Clair, moved that the discussion become general, and occupied a considerable length of time.

On motion, the Convention took a recess until half past one o'clock.

THE AFTERNOON SESSION.

J. W. F. White, from Swickley, spoke at length on the subject of the remaking of the members of the Convention.

The Convention proceeded to fix the amount of salary by calling the roll, each delegate naming his name in the list of the 3d Ward School Board House this evening, for the purpose of electing a Board of Commissioners.
