Proceeding on the ground of these alarms, Congress adopted another compromise, the terms of which were that \$10,000,000 of the people's money should be given to Texas to induce her to reliquidant very doubtfal claim upon an inconsiderable part of New Mexico; that New Mexico and Utah should be organized without an inhibition of slavery, and that they should be afterwards admitted as alves or free States, as the people when forming constitutions should determine; that the public alare trade in the District of Columbia should be admitted as provisions for the recapture of fugitive slaves, of disputed constitutionality, should be adopted; and that on these conditions California should be admitted as after State.
