THREE DAYS LATER FROM EUROPE.

ARRIVAL OF THE ARABIA.

New York, Aug. 10.—The steamer Arabia arrived this evening with Liverpool to date from the 29th ult.

The past week has been a quiet one, but with marked tendency to improvement. The Philadelphians ledger says: "The steamer is pleasant; that is, a class paper is scarce at present, and the box containing a large amount of jewelry stolen from a safe in New York, and efforts to discover the thief at the time, have proved unavailing. Circumstances have since transpired which show the thief was not only discovered, but which he is now in safe custody."—*Continued.*

It appears that on Friday night, a son of Mrs. Powers, of Grant street, offered a gold lock-set to a female friend that he had found it in the door of her room. This was a girl of Grant street, being captivated with its richness and beauty, proposed taking it at the price fixed—five cents—and left it to his father for the money. The father first asked him if he would do it with it, but after consulting some gentlemen, present, concluded to take it and find its owner, and so he did. On Saturday he had the man arrested, took the girl to see him, and the master of the lad called on Howe and demanded the property. Howe interrogated the lady closely, and ascertained that there was a mystery in the matter. He, however, offered to pay up the lock-set if she would return the fifty cents but also have the money, stepped out to get it, and on his return, a very ingenious and satisfactory explanation was given him, which he accepted, and the girl was returned to her owner.

There is no war now.

The Spanish revolution is still triumphant—All was quiet awaiting Espartero's arrival at Madrid.

The war news is exceedingly scant. It is evident that the Casar will not abide his pretensions. His reply to Alfonso's summons is not yet received, but it is known that he is a mystery and unfavorable. The Austrian Government, however, says in general terms, that Austria will not disown the Emperor.

There is still the late appearance of siding with the Western Powers.

Mechlenberg was the only state of Germany not having unanimously adopted the Austrian Prussian alliance.

Gortchakoff, owing to the Turkish movements, is withdrawing his forces on Bucharest and thence upon the Sea of Azov. The Casar apparently has given up all idea of war, and orders him to cease his offensive operations.

There has been no fighting anywhere since the last news.

Queen Pachas has proclaimed an amnesty to the Wallachians.

From the Baltic there is nothing.

The Russian war schooner Wolga was captured by the English squadron in the White Sea.

The Russian fleet is expected to have left Scapa Flow on the 11th in search of the Casar.

The Spanish insurrection remains triumphant. The position of Alfonso is unchanged. The fight continues, but the country is more or less quiet, awaiting Espartero's arrival.

It is reported that the Christians, who had chosen Isabella as their regent, have given up the Empire, but disapprove of a Regency.

In the British Parliament, Lord Dufferin, Sir George Grey, and others, voted in favor of the Aberdeen Ministry.

The instruction in Paris had been suspended.

There was great uneasiness at Modena.

Ashbach of Egypt is dead, and the government is quickly assumed by Sarac Pacha.

The overland India Mail has arrived in England.

The American Minister to China had visited Foochow, and also proceeded up the Yangtze River to Nanking and would visit Yellow River.

It is reported that the Casar has named Count James Reiss, Andrew Moon, John Vandegrift, and Leopold W. M. Everard, Attachments to the State Department, to the Supreme Court, and the number here will exceed that of any previous season.

CHURCH.—We understand that Rev. N. West, Jr., formerly of the Fifth Presbyterian Church, of Pittsburgh, has accepted a call from the Nixon church, Cincinnati, Ohio.

RUE OVER.—A young lad named Joseph Cupola, who was over from the Republic Legion on Monday evening while going to the fire, was not seriously injured.

FOUR.—About 10 o'clock on Monday evening, a fire broke out in a brick stable on a lot near Irwin street, Pittsburgh, owned by Mr. Thomas Scott, a well-known Munro, keeper of the Allegheny Hotel, at the foot of Market street. The stable was entirely consumed, but by the prompt attendance of the fire companies, the fire was extinguished beyond the building in which it originated.

RESCUED.—A colored boy, who was run over by an automobile on Market street, was severely injured, but has since recovered from the effects of his injuries.

THE man, who was established on Rebecca street, in Allegheny, two weeks before last, was covered from his injuries, and is now able to be about.

We Grieve, the young man cut by McFadden, was somewhat better yesterday evening, and it is thought will recover.

The Allegheny Post Office is almost complete, it will be ready for occupancy in a few days.

TAXES were none of the Courts in session yesterday; the Judges, with one exception, being all absent from the city.
