

Overland Stage Line to California.—A meeting has been held in St. Louis, and arrangements made to form a company to establish an overland stage line between Missouri and Kansas, and thence to California. The project is to adopt a line across the plains and through the mountains, and locate stations, say every fifty miles, or thirty miles apart, at the convenience of the country which may improve the same by permanent termini, stations and enclosures. A few men being placed at each station as a means of protection, and the same men being placed at each station, for changes and relays, the line would commence operations, under the general superintendence of the agent in charge, and life commence on the plains. The stages would be run as regularly and with as much speed as is accomplished on any present route in the United States.

Historical Associations in the Western States.—This subject is now attracting great attention, and it is important that the people be well informed in regard to it. The following is a list of the associations that are now in existence:

Section 3 of Article XII.—The Constitution of the State of Kentucky provides for the election of a Governor and a Lieutenant Governor. The Governor shall hold office for four years, and shall be eligible for re-election.

Section 4 of Article XII.—The Governor shall have the honor and respect due his office, and shall be protected in the exercise of his powers. He shall be impeachable for treason, bribery, or other high crimes and misdemeanors.

Section 5 of Article XII.—The Governor shall have the right to pardon and commute the punishment of criminals, subject to the right of the Legislature to alter or modify the same.

Section 6 of Article XII.—The Governor shall have the right to remove any officer or agent in whose appointment he has concurred, for inefficiency or neglect of duty.

Section 7 of Article XII.—The Governor shall have the right to fill vacancies in any office during the term of the person appointed, and he may also fill any office which may be vacant at the time of his inauguration.
