ROBBERY OF \$4000—DARKER AFFAIR—On Saturday night, a merchant named Nichols, from Ohio, arrived in this city, on his way east, with \$4,000 in his possession, secured in a belt around his person.

At the Monongahela House he made the acquaintance of a young man who represented himself to be a clerk in a wholesale house in Philadelphia, at which Mr. Nichols intended making purchases.

The two became very intimate, and Nichols very foolishly confided to the other the fact that he had a large amount of money with him.

The two agreed to travel to Philadelphia together; but on Sunday night, at half past nine o'clock, when the train started for the east, he was seized by his companion, and took passage by himself.

At the Summer station of the railroad, in Cambria county, Nichols stepped out upon the platform of the car to see the depot.

The night was very dark, and just as the cars were again getting into motion, some one stepped from the interior of the one upon which he was standing, and struck him a violent blow upon the back of the head with a hard Billy, knocking him to the ground.

When he recovered, his person was riddled of the money, but no clue to the perpetrator could be found. Nichols came back to this city, and gave the Police information of the robbery, but nothing has as yet been discovered.
