Some little time since, a firm at Charleston, South Carolina, applied for a clearance to a vessel bound for the coast of Africa, "for the purpose of taking on board African emigranis, in accordance with the United States Passenger law, and returning with the same to some port in the United States." Mr. Secretary Cobb, to whom this application was referred by the Collector of the port of Charleston, refused to sanction it, on the ground that, if the Africans were to be brought in as slaves, or to be held to serve to be compens, while it could hardly be believed that they were to be brought in as freemen, as their landing as such was prohibited in all the slaveholding and in some of the Free States, and was desired in none.
