We are happy to say the loss on our side was very slight, only one officer, the master of the Opossum, being severely wounded by a shot in the side and thigh. We have no exact or reliable particulars of the loss on the British side, but do not hear that it exceeds 25 killed and wounded. Our allies, we are sorry to say, owing to the explosion of a mine; suffered more severely; 15 men, it is said, being killed, and 40 men wounded; some of the latter dreadfully burned and torn by the explosion. The killed are four liouteants. The Chinese stuck to their guns manfally, and there were the usual acts of self-sacrifice. One blue-buttoned mandarin was found by the French in the fort they had captured dead, beside a gun, having out his throat,; and in the ansault on the highest fort of 31 guns, a mandarin jumped out and charged the party single handed. The officers did all they could to prevent him being killed, but one of the men in the flanks, at some distance, shot him through the neck and killed him, to the regret of those near, who admired his bravery. About 38 guns were captured, 68 of which were brass or composition metal. Some were eight inch guns, but we helieve they had none of the chinese fred grape and even at simple shells, but, as their fuse was only a piece of common slow match, the shell generally burst close to the gun.

The unfortunate mandarin went away considerably crest fallen. We understand the Admiral intends to do much the same as at Cauton, eccuring the river at different points by auchoring a steamer. The river to Tien-toin is of sufficient depth for the largest ships over the bar, but above Tien-toin to Pekin, a distance of 80 miles, the water is said to be very shallow, boats drawing more than five feet not being able to ascend. It is said that it was Lord Righ's intention to push on at once to Pekin, and only in that city pagotiate, for the effective carrying out of which idea he had sent down for releforcements. Where they are to come from is by no means clear, looking to the safety of the colony and the Cauton garrison. Her Majesty a 59th are under orders, and perhapa the 77th Bongal Native Infantry, or the other antire acrys here, might be spared; but it is hard to bay what the summer may produce of sinkness in the Canton garfison, and a few of the foreign inhabitants here will doubt that atthough we get overything we desire at Pekin, we have still a good deal of fighting to do at Canton, and its neighborheed.
