One farmer who had thirty acres of clover, from which he expected a week or two ago to gather a full crop of seed, informs us that he will not have a handful—the whole tract having been literally devoured by these pests, which swarm in myrisds in every field. We have also heard of several instances where the young buckwheat has been eaten off and destroyed. They commence at the edge of the field, and eat everything as they go, and if we do not have a heavy rain or? something else to drive them off, late pasture will be very scarce, in several townships."
