"At the present moment the people of this city are in great excitement at the indications of a dangerous cruption from Mount Vesuvius. For a long time great masses of lava have been issuing from apertures on the side of the mountain, about half way up; and these apertures have been augmenting in number and size so rapidly that not only is there apprehension of an eruption, but serious fears are expressed that the sides of the mountain will soon be so worn and perferated as to be no longer able to sustain the subject of great fires on the sides (red-hot lays) were terribly brilliant, while the vast volume of smoke that rose slowly from the cruter above had its side illuminated by the fire on the flanks, and presented an appearance of indescribable grandeur.
