DOU TRAINS ON THE LAKES.—A letter from Bay country, Michigan, thus describes the dog trains on the Lakes, by which the mails are carried uning the winter menths:

We have, during the close of navigation, what we call the dog mail, and by the bye, i will describe to you how our mail is carried in this new and wild country. The route is from Naginar city to Green Bay or Mackinaw, by land. The contract is taken by half-breeds, French and Indian, hardy, atheletic men.
