His history during the last six menths would sound marvellous to English care, so wast is the extent of territory which he has traversed, so miraculous has been his escape from the columns which were despatched in his pursuit. Indeed, his activity carries us back to the days of the old Mahratta chieftsins, and his courage and perseverance awake a sympathy scarcely repressed by the recollection of his crimes. He it was who marched down with the Gwalior men from Calpee upon Sir Hugh Rose, who drove Scindia from his throne, and whose influence and power caused more than one powerful rajah to devote his army and his fortune to the rebel cause. Worsted whenever he turned to bay, he contrived to lead his dispirited followers from the banks of the Junna to the province of Guzerat, and then retraced his footsteps through the midst of the columns assembled to effect his capture. The whole of Central India was traversed in his rapid flight, and it is not going too far to say that towards the close of his career he gave employment to the armies, and excited the constant alarms of the three presidencies.

The native chiefanis who still refuse allegiance to the British authorities are represented as much inferior to Tantia Topee, their leading spirit, and there was reason to hope that all would soon return to subjection.
