Milan is a very ancient city, being founded 400 years before the Christian era. It was inhabited and embellished by many of the Roman Emperors, and has been the birth place of many eminent men, including a number of Popes. This city, though besteged forty times, and forty times taken, and four times destroyed, still contains a vast number of oburches, colleges, nunneries and schools, and many stately buildings, both public and private. The Cathedral, begun in 1836, is one of the finest in the world. It also contains the Church of St. Ambregio, where the Emperors of Germany were crowned. The city is nearly of a circular shape, enclosed on three sides by a wall, surrounded by ramparts, nearly eight miles in circumference, and ontered by ten gates. It is distant from Vicana about 400 miles.
