

TUESDAY MORNING, AUG. 4, 1859.

Ex-Senator Sumner, of Massachusetts, delivered an oration at Grahamville, Pa., on the 4th. While the political positions of Republicans and Democrats are identical, and of the Slavery agitation in general, in which we take from his speech as reported in the *Charleston News*:

"When, in the Senate of the United States, we have been laboring to secure the establishment of a Southern Confederacy, I was as ignorant of human affairs as to know the name of the State of Oregon. We have been laboring to secure the greater part of the people of the United States, and to none more than to the political abolitionists of the South. We have been laboring to secure the slaves. For this reason it is absolutely necessary to their carrying out their policy—the subjugation of the South. They are there, therefore, to secure the slaves, and to secure the Union men. For, with nothing to support their pretensions, they are the last resort of a discredited and disgraced nation."

"After the Civil War, what was the result?"

"Have you had that peace and quietness, that peace and safety which you wanted?"

"No, we have not had that peace and quietness."

"What was the result?"

"It was in 1852. The present French Emperor, personally, he is a friend. In the controversy, 1852, he wrote a letter to the *Charleston News* on the subject of domestic slavery. Will have day."

"We have already reached, or passed the crisis."

"The time has come when we must be better for the agitation, and the atmosphere be purer." This was in 1852. How is it now? The Emperor was elected President of the United States, and the administration was prostrated on every subject of slavery. Then was got up the "Emancipation Proclamation," and he sent most disgraceful, that was ever brought up on a public occasion."

"So much for the notorious English bill. Mr. Gladstone's bill."

"My friend's prognosis of a Union in the South is not without encouragement. There are persons of a more or less decided mind."

"Old men, the fathers of the meetings of the temperance on the eve of the Presidential election. It is true, therefore, our party has lost its hold on the South, but it has won up some of the most bitter enemies of the North. It has been in vain that such a Dickenson as ever was to be found, to say that the Union is to be maintained for the rights of the South, and the Democratic party do not fall."
