Arrival of the Steamer Fulton.

New Yonz, Ang. 11.—The steamer Fulton, which left Cowes on the evening of the 37th ult, arrived here this morning. She brings one hundred and thirty paisengers, and reports having passed, on the 27th of July, ships Mercury and Wurtemberg, going to Havre; also the steam of the Morning of the Fulton's advices are not so late as those fernished by telegraph from Halifax, but her papers are one day later than have yet been received.

The advices from Paris indicate unplensant feelings towards England. An article in the Moniteur, discrediting the rumored probability of an accord between France and England on the question of the Congress, and a general disarnament, had produced a painful impression.
