This Whear Cross.—A letter from Peoris Co.

III., gives rather a gloomy prospect of seeing all the debts to Eastern merchants canceled out of the present wheat or Fo. He says:

"After the people of Illinois are all fed for the next twelve months, a smilicency of seeing saved, and the hired help paid, there will not be left one bushel of wheat in this State, to pay merchants of New York old debts, or to buy imported gways for future use. If there is no more sbillity in other States to buy and pay for the imports of the last nine months than exists in this part of the West, then, most assuredly, financial ruin will overtake many of your importing merchants. A pretty extensive acquaintance with the crops within a circuit of fly miles around this place, enables me to say with confidence that the average of wheat will not exceede light bushels to the acre. This is not the yield anticipated. The price—45 to 50 ets.—does not pay the farmer one per cent on the outlay."

The statement as to the yield is confirmed by a dozen other letters.
