Estados Mexicanos in Mexico.—A few weeks back reports came from Antwerp, Belgium, and a half million of dollars were afterward brought to Paris by the Captain, who had returned to England.

The Captain is an English shipowner and agent to the Mexican Government, and it must be said that he has been most successful in his efforts to bring about the peace in that part of Mexico destined for foreign ports, and defrauded the Mexican Government of a very large amount of money.

The Captain is a receiving species at Guayaquil, and proceeded down the coast to Nachita, Atala, Ajusco, and other points. From there he proceeded to San Blas and so on to small ports below, where she received \$3,000,000 more, making the sum total of her receipts \$10,000,000.

The expert duty of this officer, according to the reports, will be to collect \$10,000,000.
