

THE MANUFACTURE OF IRON FROM THE ORE IN AND AROUND PITTSBURGH. The article which appeared in the Pittsburgh Gazette, on the manufacture of iron from the ore at the Pioneer Clinton Furnace of Graf, Bennett & Co., has been extensively copied and commented upon.

Without following "St. Louis" step by step in our investigations, we wish to call for his candid and a few facts which will afford him and the public generally who may feel interested in this matter, sufficient data for any estimates they may desire to make.

Heretofore, the principal supply of pig iron for this market has been derived from the counties of this State and from the upper Allegheny region. One reason which would have been called for, when we were told that a "black hand" had been discovered in the Allegheny region, which would yield a better quality of iron than any other, was that it was supposed to be obtained from either when worked separately.

During the three years last past, however, various districts of iron ore and coal have been made known in a direct or indirect manner. One of these is the Allegheny region, which is situated in the Allegheny valley. There are now in our knowledge four large basins of iron ore in process of being developed in this region, having a total area of about 100,000 acres.

On the Ohio, Beaver and Mahoning rivers, as well as along the line of our different railroads, ore, coal and limestone in large quantities have been and are being discovered. At Johnstown, the Cambria Iron Works, where railroad iron is manufactured, last year one experienced in the iron business visited that place and ascertained the cost of manufacturing pig iron, and then returned to this city, and made a statement. The latter fact can be learned from almost any railroad man in this city.
