## CABINET PRACTICES AND OPINIONS.

The telegraph announces that two Heads of Departments have avowed their purpose to be to dispense no patronage through their admission to "The Presidents Cabinet." ## GOVERNOR ANDREW.

COOPER, of Bradford, and John W. GANNON, of Cambria. At the present moment it looks as if the contest were between the first named two.
