—The following are given as the points of a bill introduced by Mr. Hooper in the House of Representatives:  It extends the act of March 3, 1885, and empowers the Secretary of the Treasury to sell any description of the bonds authorized which act, at rates not below par, and to receive in payment therefor any axisting actes, bonds or certificates.
