UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD

Report of Springer Harbaugh, Esq.

PITTSBURGH, May 17, 1906.

Sir:—In compliance with the duties imposed upon me by the Government, I have the honor to report to you the result of my examination of the Union Pacific Railroad.

At the request of the Vice President, I accompanied him to Omaha, Nebraska, on Saturday, April 27th, and spent several days on the line of operation, as a personal examination of everything that would tend to give me an intelligent view touching the condition, management and progress of the work. On our return to the initial point at Omaha, I found the buildings, temporary, the House and Saw Mill, considerable construction material, and the low river base of the Company's operations on the Missouri to average depth of say from one to three feet. The general business of the Company was interrupted about two weeks from the 26th of April until the 7th of May. By the active management and exertions of Samuel B. Reed, Esq., Secretary, Superintendent, his assistants, and employees, the Company's movable property was, in a comparatively short time, and in a manner which I am pleased to be able to report the Company's permanent interests and work shops are situated on elevated ground further from the river, and not in the immediate vicinity of the low water mark. It would have taken from four to five months to complete the work, had the Company not been so ably assisted by the State of Iowa, with the Union Pacific Railroad. These lines will be feeder as well as receivers of a considerable amount of traffic.

The theory, I am convinced, will be verified, and that the great through line is, in fact, opened for business and in successful operation. The Union Pacific Railroad, which is a great success, is now in a position to receive and handle a large amount of traffic, and to be able to do so in a manner which will be a credit to the Company and to the State of Iowa.
