THE CHRONIC BROGLED.—The first Internal Revenue law which was enacted, dated July 1, 1862, provided that income tax of three per cent should be levied on all incomes under ten thousand dollars, and that upon all incomes over ten thousand dollars, there should be levied from interest upon bonds, stocks and securities of the United States, there should be levied a duty of one and one-half per cent per annum.
