Germany and Austria.

These are the principal allies of Austria among the minor German States. They will probably continue faithful to her as long as the fortunes of the great European war, they allied to the Emperor Napoleon, will raise them from principalities to kingdoms until the hour of his reverses and then they deserted him for a stronger alliance.

On the great battle-field of Leipzig, fought in October, 1813, 50,000 Prussian troops, who were intrusted with an important position in the host of the emperor, gave to those they had left the benefit of their guns and bayoneted trenchery greatly increased the defeat of the French, and obliged them to retire from Germany.

On the other hand the weaker party generally satiates itself with defensive preparations, and in this light we cannot help seeing the inactivity of the Austrians, although we admit that there are few roles without exceptions. We cannot help feeling amused when we read sentences like the following in our exchanges: Austria has suffered the Prussians to possess themselves of Dresden and of Leipzig, to gain tactical advantages, but only wait; it is undoubtedly for good reasons. Let the Prussians fortify themselves; Bismarck will soon push forward and drive the invaders back.
