The receipts of the preceding two years were \$3,700 33, showing an excess during the past two years of \$442 56. The number of missionaries supported by the society is eleven. The number is small, but the fields they occupy are of great relative importance.

Statistics of Churches receiving Missionary aid.—Number received by baptism, 207; number received by certificate, 231; number of communicants, 1,875; number of Sunday school scholars, 2,035; number of churches built, 2. These figures, however, do not represent the progress made in the Home Mission work.
