BRAHMOGRAPHY. An Historical Novel. By A. E. DICKENSON, author of "Ninety-Nine," "Etcetera," etc. Translated from the German, by Theodore J. Bradford. Illustrated by Gustav Fay. Published by D. Appleton & Co., New York.

There is a novelty about this work that seizes the reader's attention at the outset. Like the Mulbach historical novels, there are woven romance and history in such harmonious blending that it possesses unusual interest. Characters appear in the well constructed plot that have occupied prominence in history. There is an exuberant style in the work that would be objectionable were it not that it faithfully represents the age in which the leading characters lived. The volume is handsomely illustrated by Gustav Fay.

OLD DECCAN DAYS, or Hindoo Fairy Legends current in Southern India. Translated from the original in French. Published by J. B. Lippincott & Co., Philadelphia.

This is a singular book in some respects, and yet there is much in it to command, especially to young people. People who are interested in and fond of the peculiarities of Indian social life, will find much in this volume to instruct and amuse. These legends are drawn from the genuine traditions of the common people of the Deccan. There are also oriental features, which are interesting and exciting, and useful lessons may be learned from this little volume, especially of the love of that far country. There is a lively, plausibility of style about the work which commands it.

FOLLY AT FLAMES; Hit by Fanny Fern. Published by G. W. Carlton & Co., New York. For sale by W. A. Gildehenny, Pittsburgh.
