CITY COUNCILS.

Adjourned Meeting—The Report of Districting Committee Adopted as Amended. An adjourned meeting of City Councils was held yesterday at two o'clock, to consider the report of the Committee appointed to redistrict the city.

Selected.

Members present—Messrs. A. M. Brown, Cochran, Collier, Dickinson, Gallatin, Green, Kehew, Lander, McAllister, Mclelland, McLean, Oliver, Phillips, Rice, Shipton, Walnicht, White, and President McAttee. The President stated that it would be necessary for Select Council to remain in session until after Common Council had taken some action, which had been before the Districting Committee, which had been before Select Council at the preceding meeting, and that they were ready to transact any other business which might be brought up.

Mr. A. M. Brown moved that Councils recede from the vote passing "an ordinance creating the Greensburg turnpike Company" to a third reading.

After considerable discussion, the resolution was adopted.

Major Brown then moved that the matter be adjourned until the next regular meeting. The motion was adopted.

Mr. Morrow submitted the following resolution:

Resolved, That the Committee of five be appointed to propose the wards.

Mr. Ogden moved that the ordinance repealing was not adopted.

Mr. Ogden moved that the ordinance repealing an ordinance for widening Chestnut street, Lawrenceville, which was adopted in Common Council, and laid on the table by Select Council, be taken up.

Mr. Kehew opposed the passage of the ordinance. He said the street should be made sixty feet wide instead of forty feet.

The motion was not adopted.

Mr. Mclelland offered the following resolution:

Resolved, That the Street Committee be and are hereby directed to have the necessary sewerage construction in the Diamond Square. Adopted.

Common Council.

On motion the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Mr. Bratt presented a petition from the proprietors of Clark street, in the Sixth ward, praying for the grading, paving and curbing of that street from Crawford to Miller streets. Referred to the Street Committee.

Mr. Bratt stated that the Street Committee would like to recall the ordinance changing the names of streets. There being no objection, the ordinance was permitted to be withdrawn for the needed alterations.

Dr. Gross, from the Select Council, was admitted to the floor, having been instructed by the Select Council to report to the Common Branch, the action of that body on the report of the re-districting of the city. He read the resolution.

Cap. Borden moved that the action of Select Council be concurred in, which was promptly seconded.

Mr. Sims objected to the irregularity of the numbering, as shown in the case of the 10th street.

Mr. Brush thought the ordinance should be concurred in, and the numbers, where wrong, could be changed in the future, as it was a matter of convenience.

Mr. Burton stated on the floor, and endorsed, an amendment, which was ruled out of order by the Chair.

Mr. Robb moved that the ordinance be acted upon by ward, and not as a whole, in the event of its being referred.

Rob. called for the ayes and nays on the question.

The vote resulted as follows:

So the resolution prevailed.

The ordinance was then taken up, and the boundaries of the wards separately. When the Third was separated from Mr. Torley moved to non-concurrence with the Select branch, and to restore the boundary line formerly drawn down Washington street.

Mr. Wedges said if opportunity were afforded him he could satisfactorily show that ward was a gross injustice and outrage on his constituents.

Mr. Caskey raised a point of order which was sustained by Mr. Borden and Mr. Weller, who were obliged to yield the floor.

The motion of Mr. Torley was voted down, and Mr. Reed moved to concur with the action of Select Council, which was ruled out. Mr. Burton moved to non-concurrence, and asked to introduce an amendment. The chair ruled the amendment in order, and Mr. Borden read the following as a substitute:

That the line begin at a point on the Pennsylvania Railroad and at the line of Liberty and Pitt Township, thence by said line to the line dividing Liberty and Pitt Township, thence by said line to the township road leading from Main Street to the line by said road to the new street leading past Roup Station to Central Avenue, thence by Central Avenue to Pennsylvania Avenue, and so on to the line of the former.

The amendment was voted an almost unanimous vote, and the section as well as all the remaining ones, was concurred in.

On motion of Mr. Robison the entire ordinance was read three times, and ordered to be printed. (It will be found on page 812 of this paper.)

There being no other business Common Council adjourned.
