The Board of Health continues its vigilant investigation into the alleged poisoned stock of cattle brought to our abattoirs from the West.

The Health Board state that there need be no cause for panic. But few diseased animals, if any, have been brought over from the New Jersey side, and they have been, ere this, eaten.

Some specimens of the diseased viscera were exhibited yesterday at the Chambers of the Board. The meat, which is all tainted with the pest, is soft and wet, and discharges serum freely.

The present cattle plague is defined as a form of the malignant typhus, which afflicts the grazing districts of the West, certain death is the result to all other cattle in contact with them.
