Money rather more active at 4 1/2 per cent on call loans.

There is a general feeling in favor of putting up the rate 1 per cent which will likely be carried into effect the beginning of next week. Sterling call at 109 1/2 @ 110, Gold firm and opened at 146 1/2, declined to 145 1/2, and closed at 146 1/4 @ 147. The export to-day was \$24,450; for the week, \$633,328. Governments heavy and lower. The fact that the gold loans are not considered closed by the Treasury Department tends to weaken the Government bond market. There is growing a fear of further losses in the Department should want more currency.
