NEW YORK, October 3, 1898. MONEY AND GOLD.

The great feature of Wall Street this afternoon was the sudden and marked change in the money market.

Money was offered with the greatest profusion and there was a break in the rates of interest from 7 to 5 and 6 per cent.

After three o'clock, and to 3 per cent. just before that hour, with a general desire to accept almost any rate for the sake of making interest for the two days.

A large amount was returned to the banks, including one lot of four millions from the Erie brokers' firm.

Sterling quiet at 108 1/2 @ 109. Gold firm, opening at 140 1/2, advancing to 140 3/4, declining to 139 3/4, and closing at 140 3/4 @ 140 1/2.
