Place of Next Conference—Reports and Resolutions—Thanks—The Town and People.

New Philadelphia, Pa., March 22, 1899.

The hour's prayer meeting has just closed. It was one of great interest. Dr. Pershing in reading the minutes of Saturday's proceedings.

Johnstown, Brownsville, Pennsylvania, avenue, Pittsburgh, Kramer Chapel, Steubenville, Salem, Alliance, Brighton, Kittanning, asked for the next session of our Conference, and Johnstown was selected.

The Conference resolved to raise \$11,000 for its claims for the coming year.

The Bishops are requested to fix the time of holding the session of our Conference in the latter part of April.

A resolution passed that the preachers be careful to see that a fair, full vote be taken in June, as ordered by the last General Conference.

In the report of the Committee on Temperance a resolution was reported and adopted to the effect that a member of our Church who sells or peddles for him or her self intoxicating drinks, violates the spirit of the Discipline, and ought to be admonished of the error of his way by his pastor.

At two o'clock p. m. Conference met for its closing session.

The report on the State of the Church has a resolution in it which was adopted, disapproving of all church fairs and festivals, and condemning dancing and stage-going.

The assets of the Pittsburgh Christian Advocate exceed its liabilities by \$12,000, and it has a circulation of 15,000 copies.

Editors received the commendation of the Conference for the able and efficient manner in which they perform their duties.

A series of resolutions of thanks were passed by a unanimous and very hearty vote, to the citizens of New Philadelphia, for the generous manner in which they entertained the members of the Conference.

Their town is rapidly improving and bids fairly to be a city shortly.

The church in which the Conference held its sessions is a new building, large, well-furnished and furnished, has a tower and steeple, and a well-toned bell, from the foundry of Mr. Fulton, of our city. It is by far the best church in the place.

Two things specially worthy of note respecting the citizens of New Philadelphia, are the religious tone of all its proceedings and the great number of people in constant attendance. Both of these were themes of conversation among all the members of the Conference, even among the oldest members.
