PROOF OF RESIDENCE. Residence within the State may be proved in the same manner as age, but the fact of residence within the proper election district, MUST BE PROVED BY HIS OWN OATH and the testimony of at least one qualified elector and competent witness...

PROOF OF NATURALIZATION. The only evidence of naturalization is the certificate under the seal of a competent court, produced to the election officers. Its LOSS AND CONTENTS CANNOT BE PROVEN IN ANY CASE.

PROOF OF PAYMENT OF TAXES. May be found by the production of the receipt for the payment of tax, and oath of the person himself or other competent witness. If he fails to produce such receipt he must make oath to the genuineness of the receipt must be proved.

PROOF OF OPPOSING EVIDENCE. Evidence may be produced against any person claiming the right to vote, or to contradict the evidence in his behalf.

GENERAL MATTERS. Any election officer or qualified elector has the right to challenge any person offering to vote, and when objection is thus made it is the duty of the inspectors to require such person to prove his right to vote...
